MOTION TO SEAL OR EXPUNGE RECORD

The Court has provided this paperwork for the purpose of assisting individuals who want to apply to have a record sealed or expunged in this Court. This Motion must be completed prior to the case being set for a hearing. The time for filing a motion is set forth in R.C. 2953.31.

Return the completed motion to the Lebanon Municipal Court Clerk's office. If you were convicted, you must pay a filing fee of \$50.00. You will not be charged a filing fee if your case was dismissed, or you were found not guilty,

The Clerk will return a time-stamped copy of the motion to you, with a hearing date included. Your presence **IS REQUIRED** at this hearing.

Prior to the hearing, you may be contacted by the Court's Probation Department or Clerk to obtain additional information. You must respond promptly to any request for information from a Court representative.
